**ORDINANCE NO. 13-87**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 86-03**

**THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HARING ORDAINS:**

Section 1.     Amendment of Section I of Ordinance No. 86-03. Section I of Ordinance No. 86-03 is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

Section I.     That the Charter Township of Haring adopts by reference the Water Supply Cross Connection Rules of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (or its successor agency) (currently R 325.11401 to R 325.11407 of the Michigan Administrative Code), as now or hereafter amended.

The Township, or the Wexford County Department of Public Works acting on behalf of the Township, shall have the authority to promulgate rules for the implementation of this Ordinance including, but not limited to, the formulation, implementation, and enforcement of a cross connection control program.

Section 2.     Section II of Ordinance No. 86-03. Section II of Ordinance No. 86-03 is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

Section II.     That representatives of the Township, or the Wexford County Department of Public Works acting on behalf of the Township, shall have the right to enter, at any reasonable time, any property served by a connection to the Township's public water supply system for the purpose of inspecting the piping system or systems thereof for cross connections. On request, the owner, lessees or occupants of any property so served shall furnish to the Township or Wexford County Department of Public Works representative inspecting the premises any pertinent information regarding the piping system or systems on such premises. The refusal to provide such information or refusal of access to the premises for such inspection, when requested, shall be deemed evidence of the presence of cross connections.


Section 3.     Amendment of Section VI of Ordinance No. 86-03. Section VI of Ordinance No. 86-03 is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

Section VI.     That the provisions of this Ordinance regulating cross connections supplement any existing state, county or Township plumbing codes and Ordinance No. 86-01, as amended, and, to the extent there is a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and the provisions of those codes, the provisions of the codes shall govern.


Section 4. Severability. If any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, said invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 5. Publication; Effective Date. This Ordinance or summary thereof, shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the boundaries of the Township within 30 days after its adoption. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption as provided by law.






